Teacher Mentor for Teacher Induction Program: Up to twenty (20) teachers, K to 12th grade will be hired to facilitate professional development sessions for Cohort 2 (please see schedule of dates below)Date of Request: March 2 2019								
<ul> <li>The Teacher Induction program is designed to provide teachers with a state-approved full year of professional development. All teachers who currently hold a Level I teaching certificate in Pennsylvania are required to complete Induction order to convert to a Level II certificate. Sessions will be facilitated by exemplary teachers currently working in the School District of Philadelphia who are looking to mentor teachers in years 0-6 and lead professional development on best practices to support the professional growth of novice teachers. Facilitators for this cohort will lead sessions at Fels High School or lead sessions at Philadelphia Military Academy. Teacher enrollment in induction by location will determine the need for number of facilitators at each location.</li> <li>This teacher facilitator position requires the selected teacher to contribute to the Induction Program by: <ul> <li>Participating in all mentor trainings and script reviews.</li> <li>Facilitating a maximum of 10 professional development sessions incumbent upon the cohort for which they facilitate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>								
<ul> <li>Review, assess, and provide feedback on teacher portfolios</li> <li>Job Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:         <ul> <li>Attend and participate in all after school script review sessions from 5:00pm-6:00pm paid at the contractual PD rate. Please note the 1st script review will be held in person and will take place from 4:30pm-6:30pm and will be paid at the contractual PD rate.</li> <li>Optional participation: participate in after school 5:00pm-6:00pm (School Year) PD sessions to enhance the delivery of content, paid at the contractual PD rate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Facilitate a maximum of 10 professional development sessions 9:00am-1:00pm and/or 4:30pm-7:00pm for Cohort 2 paid at the contractual Leader rate.</li> <li>Communicate promptly and proactively with the Office of Teaching and Learning and Induction Coordinators.</li> <li>Incorporate feedback from the Office of Teaching and Learning team and Induction Coordinators.</li> </ul>

Facilitators will be paid at the EC rate for scoring of portfolios.</li> <li>Submit paperwork to verify that Induction participant has met all deadlines and portfolio criteria for successful completion of Induction.</li> </ul>

Be a regularly appointed certified teacher in the School District of Philadelphia with a minimum of 6 years of teaching and a demonstrated knowledge of effective instruction and classroom management **AND** 

Demonstrate effective communication skills related to facilitating adult learning through professional development.

### **Specific Criteria**

#### Specific Criteria

- 1. Have an excellent attendance and punctuality record during the last three (3) years (defined as no more than eighteen occasions of absence for personal illness or lateness during the last three (3) years). A consecutive period of absence constitutes one occasion.
- 2. Have no unsatisfactory documentation currently on file.
- 3. Be a regularly appointed and certified teacher in the School District of Philadelphia.
- 4. Complete a performance task which will be graded using a rubric from the Office of Teaching and Learning. Should there be the same score between two applicants, seniority will be the final determining factor in hiring.
