THE RESIDENCY

- Trains aspiring educators to teach Math, Science, English Language Arts, Spanish or Special Education in grades 4-12 classrooms
- Provides a yearlong teacher preparation model
- Prepares residents for PA State Instructional I certification
- Leverages graduate coursework with residency partner, which often leads to a Master's degree
- 4-year commitment to serving Philadelphia students:
 - Year 1: Teacher Resident
 - Years 2-4: Certified Teacher

- \$7,500 tuition stipend ۲
