Essential Functions

Develop social studies instructional resources (scope and sequence/ year at a glance) for Kindergarten through grade 3 that align with PA Academic Standards, Common Core State State Standards, National Council for Social Studies C3 Framework, disciplinary literacy and anti-racist pedagogical practices

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Create engaging authentic performance tasks that align with the social studies professional development plan, curricular content, key pedagogical practices and key initiatives
- Develop and align a bank of instructional resources that support each authentic tasks

Must Agree To

- Attend 3-4 hour virtual orientation and training sessions
- Collaborate with other content creators
- Monthly virtual collaborative content development sessions
- Develop up to 8 authentic tasks with aligned supportive resources per assigned grade

Requirements

- Possess valid PA teaching certificate
- Previous experience creating and implementing authentic tasks preferred
- Previous experience developing curriculum preferred
- Previous experience developing learning experiences through the social studies disciplinary literacy lens
- Have a minimum 5 years classroom teaching experience specifically teaching social studies Kindergarten, First, Second, Third grade
- Demonstrate effective communication skills, and display the ability to function as a constructive team member when working with peers and administrators
- Have an excellent attendance and punctuality record during the last (3) years (defined as no more than 18 occasions of absence for personal illness, illness in the family or lateness during the last 3 years. A consecutive period of absence constitutes one occasion)
- Have no anecdotal record on file and have not been subject to any disciplinary action within the last (18) months.
- Be a regularly appointed teacher in the School District of Philadelphia
